



**Transfer Program to Avila University  
Education, B.S. (Elementary and Special Education)  
(For those students transferring to Avila Fall 2006 and after.)**

❖ **Secondary Education minors may also follow this guide. Approval as an education major requires:**

- SAT or ACT scores
- a minimum 2.5 GPA with minimum "C" grades in English I, II, Speech and Math.
- a passing score on the C-BASE for Missouri Certification (ask about Kansas Certification requirements)

❖ A minimum of 128 is required for the degree; at least 64 semester hours must be completed at four-year institutions. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila. All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C.

**III. LEVEL III — APPLICATIONS AND INTEGRATION (NO TWO-YEAR COLLEGE EQUIVALENT FOR LEVEL III)**

Students may register for Level III courses only after completing Level I requirements and 15 credit hours of Level II requirements.
