 (For those students transferring to Avila Fall 2005 and after.)

Approval to Avila's School of Education requires a minimum 2.5 GPA with at least a "C" grade in English I, II, Speech and Math; and a passing score on the C-Base for Missouri Certification.

A maximum of 64 semester hours of two-year college credit will be accepted toward the total hours required for a degree; a minimum of 64 semester hours must be completed at a four year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer hours. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila. All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of a C.
